### *Plastic Milk Jugs*

Rinsed and lids removed.

### *Plastic Pop Containers*

Rinsed and lids removed.

### *Computer Paper*

Green, blue or green/orange bar only.

### *White Office Paper*

Typing paper, laser or ink jet paper, copy paper.  
No Colored papers. No adhesives or plastic window envelopes.
